







2024 Footfall Figures for West Bromwich Town Centre


Bull Street, High Street, Princess Parade, Duchess Parade, West Bromwich Ringroad, New Street, St Michaels Street, Carters Green








Footfall 2024 High Street/Carters Green

Safer Travel

Safer Travel is a unique partnership made up of officers and staff from West Midlands Police, British Transport Police and Transport for West Midlands.





ur aim is to tackle crime and anti-social behaviour on the public transport network. We conduct daily patrols of the entire network across the region, and use tactical operations to make the transport network safer.

We work with transport operators and West Midlands Combined Authority to investigate reports of crime and anti-social behaviour, run targeted campaigns to encourage reporting and conduct operations to keep transport staff and passengers safe.

Our monthly tasking meeting involves all of our

partners to identify hotspots or crime patterns to help us focus our teams where they need to be. A tactical assessment is produced every month by our intelligence team, enabling us to ensure we are in the right places. To allow the public to contribute to this we encourage reporting of any Anti-Social Behaviour experienced on buses to be reported via our 'See Something Say Something' campaign. It's simple to do, just text SeeSay to 81018 with details of the bus route, time, location and what the issue was on your journey.


Another of our campaigns is Project Empower where we raise awareness of, and encourage victims of unwanted sexual behaviour on the transport network to report to police.

Project Empower materials are displayed on buses and at transport hubs across the region. The posters ask people to report behaviours such as inappropriate touching, stalking, harassment and sexual comments. Passengers can report to us by scanning a QR code and opening Live Chat on the force website.

Over 1600 posters are placed on buses as well as in buses, stations, schools, universities and football stadiums. The posters aim to raise awareness of unwanted sexual behaviour and encourage people to speak to police. Transport for West Midlands (TfWM) will also include safety advice and links to report incidents on their Swift app for passengers that are purchasing tickets or planning journeys.

Reporting through Live Chat allows passengers to talk quickly and discreetly about what's happened to them. It also reduces the chance of being overheard or alerting others nearby, which can sometimes be a barrier to reporting sexual offences.

We hold regular engagement events across the region including our popular Time to Talk sessions at bus stations in the area. Most recently we teamed up with West Bromwich BID where, together we spoke with nearly 1500 passengers using both bus and metro to understand any concerns they have about travel across Sandwell. We also meet monthly with the BID team to more fully appreciate issues affecting residents.


